

# CCDOK Provides Assistance to the Portage Tornado Disaster

Charities Diocese of Kalamazoo provided over \$26,000 in assistance to support disaster relief efforts to locals impacted by the May 2024 tornado that devastated much of the Portage area. The funds were a combination of support from Catholic Charities USA and individuals who generously donated locally. Working closely with the City of Portage, the relief funds were used to aid residents whose insurance did not cover all the damage. The donations were used to help purchase a used car, provide furniture, replace roofing, siding and drywall and partner with St. Vincent DePaul USA Disaster Services to purchase "House in a Box" kits that provide families devastated by disasters with new furniture and furnishings.

Catholic Charities also assisted families in the Pavilion Estates Mobile Home Park in Portage after the tornado destroyed 17 homes and damaged more than 100. The Bread of Life food program delivered food and provided referrals to other community assistance for tornado support and family assisted recently resources. One reached out to thank our program for our support during a very challenging time where they needed extra help and to let us know they longer needed the emergency food assistance.

We would like to thank everyone who has supported the recovery efforts in Portage through donations, prayers and volunteering their time.

# Home Heating Assistance Program 2024-2025

The home heating assistance program provides up to \$300 per household to anyone in need residing within the nine counties of the Diocese of Kalamazoo (Allegan, Barry, Berrien, Branch, Calhoun, Cass, Kalamazoo, St. Joseph, and Van Buren), which helps households defray heating expenses and obtain heating resources (fuel oil, natural gas, electricity, firewood, etc).

The program is generously funded through a special collection taken in November -- with funds contributed from more than 50 parishes and missions across the Diocese of Kalamazoo. The parishes/missions may keep 20% of the funds collected for local use, serving the poor and vulnerable. The remaining 80% is contributed to the program and given out to families in need.
